

Teachers: “How Can I Help Today?”

Teachers play a vital role in making the YES! event successful. Your excitement and involvement is a huge factor in student engagement. Here are some ways that you can help:



- Have your classroom set-up for the YES! activity assigned to your classroom the afternoon before your event. Refer to the bottom of your YES! day schedule for set-up instructions/desk groupings.
- Be sure your door is open/unlocked in the morning for JA staff to ensure proper setup and to bring the volunteers to their assigned rooms.
- Ensure students have only pencils for the day. Backpacks and devices should be left in lockers or in an out-of-the-way area of their homeroom.
- Please be in the classroom with the students at all times.
- Handle any classroom management issues so that the volunteers can focus on their activity.
- As students enter the classroom, help seat the students in equal groups (if needed).
- Assist the volunteer with technology (if needed), videos are required for the following activities:
